Introduction to the Scholarship Guide

Additionally, external scholarships each have a unique set of application criteria and deadlines and students should be mindful of these details as they apply. We encourage you to explore and apply for outside scholarships.

All information is subject to change, and availability is based on the foundation's providing the opportunity. Questions on the opportunities should be directed to the organization offering the opportunity.

Outside scholarship funds are considered a resource to a student's ability to meet educational cost. You must notify the Office of Financial Aid immediately of all scholarships received.

Students should take all precautions when applying for external scholarships. Scammers take advantage of that, saying they'll help you get financial aid or scholarships but really, they are trying to take your money or steal your personal information. Abbvie Immunology Scholarship

- Eligibility: For students impacted by inflammatory diseases such as AS, AD, CD, HS, JIA, Ps, PsA, RA, UC and UV; must be U.S. citizen or a legal and permanent resident of the U.S.; enrolled full-time at university undergrad or graduate program; students selected demonstrate leadership and participation in school, community activities and/or work experience (if applicable); demonstrate community involvement; recipients also selected on basis of selected on basis of academic performance, and honors.
- Submission: Application; transcript; diagnosis verification form; one online recommendation form; essay
- Value: \$20,000

Association on American-Indian Affairs Scholarship

- Eligibility: Be enrolled with your respective Tribe, either federally recognized or non-federally recognized Tribe, from the continental U.S. or Alaska; submit a copy of Native Nation enrollment; be a full-time student; minimum 2.5 out of 4.0 GPA; submit current class schedule and transcript; provide essays described in the application that show the student's connection to their Native Nation and Native Country.

Charles Fox Medical Scholarship

- Eligibility: Graduate from Salem High School in Salem, OH. Possess bachelor degree or equivalent and completing or have completed at an accredited university one year of postgraduate coursework in pursuit of a degree in medicine, dentistry, nursing, pharmacy, optometry or a healthcare profession that requires postgraduate degree; maintain at least a 3.2 GPA or its equivalent in postgraduate education.

Health Professions Program Indian Health Service

- Eligibility: U.S. Citizen or U.S. national, and; American Indian or Alaska Native, health professions student. **Must agree to two years of service commitment in an IHSSP-approved position and an IHSSP-approved site. One year of service per year of support for the scholarship received, thereafter.** One year of service per year of support for scholarship received, thereafter). Males must be registered for Selective Service to be eligible. Must have minimum 2.0 GPA. Be capable of completing a health profession degree program. Intend to serve Indian people as a health professional in your chosen discipline.
- Submission: Application, copy of birth certificate/U.S. passport/certification of naturalization, signed IHS Scholarship Program Contract agreeing to a minimum two-year service commitment to practice at an Indian health facility upon completion of academic and/or post-graduate training.

National Federation of the Blind (NFB)

- Eligibility: Legally blind in both eyes; reside in United States, District of Columbia, or Puerto Rico; full-time post-secondary course of study in a degree program at a U.S. institution in the fall of the year of application (some scholarships for students enrolled part-time); participate in-person in the entire NFB National Convention and in all of its scheduled scholarship program activities (finalists will receive assistance to attend the national convention).
- Submission: Application; essay; letter of recommendation; proof of legal blindness; transcripts
- Value: \$8,000

National Italian American Foundation Scholarships (NIAF)

- Eligibility: Must have an active NIAF membership; enrolled in U.S. accredited institution of higher education on a full-time basis for the fall semester; have GPA of 3.5 out of 4.0; U.S. citizen or permanent resident alien; demonstrate commitment to or interest in Italian culture and heritage.

- Eligibility: High school seniors or graduates from high schools in Fairfield County, OH who are enrolled or planning to enroll in full-time study at an accredited undergraduate or graduate school for the entire upcoming academic year. Must be majoring in medical or ministry fields; students majoring in the medical field must have a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA and be pursuing authorized medical titles (see website for more details).
